**UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R**

1. An order of the High Court of Delhi rejecting the appellants' plaint under Order VII Rule 11, Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 (referring to the bar of the civil court's jurisdiction under Section 430 of the Companies Act, 2013 and the pendency of a company petition¹ before the National Company Law Tribunal², Bench at Allahabad) is under challenge in this appeal.
2. We are informed, in course of hearing, that two applications³ have been filed in connection with the company petition before the Tribunal seeking dismissal thereof on the grounds urged therein.
3. We are also informed that the applications have been heard on previous occasions by the Tribunal and are due to be heard further on 24th August, 2026.
4. Since a decision on the applications might have some bearing on the issue we are seized of, it would be in the interest of justice to adjourn hearing of this civil appeal awaiting the Tribunal's decision thereon.
5. The Tribunal may expedite its decision on the applications. Subject to its convenience, it would be desirable if the applications are decided within a month from date of conclusion of final hearing.
6. The resultant decision of the Tribunal, if rendered by the next date of
