UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. We have heard learned counsel for the State of Gujarat.
2. There is an inordinate delay of 551 days in filing the Special Leave Petition. That apart, we find that as against five LPAs, only one Special Leave Petition has been preferred on the ground that there is a common judgment disposing of all the LPAs. As a result, what has happened is that there are varying days of delay in so far different LPAs are concerned.

3. Be that as it may, the delay in respect of all the cases is more than 500 days. The explanation given for such delay does not constitute sufficient cause to warrant our interference.

4. Considering the above, the Special Leave Petition is dismissed on the ground of delay.

5. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
