2	Nature and details of the action(s) taken, initiated or order(s) passed	Two Orders dt. 08.09.2026 have been passed ordering payment of Stamp duty of Rs.18,56,181 and penalty of (1) Rs.18,93,305 pertaining to Order dt.22.06.2022 on Scheme of Amalgamation of Bharat Oman Refineries Limited with Bharat Petroleum Corporation Limited; (2) Stamp duty of Rs.1,25,534/- on a land allotment order of year 2010 and three land awards of years 2001, 2003 and 2007 and penalty of Rs.7,37,681/-. In both the orders, the authority rejected the objections of the Company regarding levy of stamp duty, penalty, and impounding of the said instruments.
