UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. Mr. Dhruv Mehta, learned senior counsel, appearing for the appellant, contends that the State of Odisha had not filed any objection under Section 9(2) of SICA within the stipulated time, i.e., 60 days, and even if the oral objection recorded on 15.05.2008 is taken into consideration, no appeal was preferred against the final order.

2. It is also contended that the scheme sanctioned between 2007-2014 would survive notwithstanding

deregistration in 2011.

3. Issue notice.

4. *Dasti*, in addition, is permitted.

5. We note that the appellant has already deposited 50% of the demand with the authority concerned. In addition to such deposit, the appellant shall deposit a further sum amounting to 25% of the demand with the authority concerned within six weeks from date and file proof thereof with the Registry of this Court.

6. Subject to such deposit, no coercive steps shall be taken against the appellant with regard to the impugned demand.

7. List the matter on 03.08.2026.
