# Corpn Commissioner reviews flood prevention infra in Adyar, Jafferkanpet

Chennai, May 29: Intensifying efforts to prepare the city for the upcoming monsoon season, Greater Chennai Corporation Commissioner G.S. Sameeran inspected key flood mitigation works in Kodambakkam Zone and reviewed the progress of desilting operations at major waterways.



The Commissioner visited the MGR Canal, Jafferkanpet Canal and the Adyar estuary, where the MGR Canal merges with the river, to assess measures being undertaken to improve water flow and prevent flooding in vulnerable areas.

During the inspection, he reviewed the ongoing desilting work at the MGR Canal near Kalaingar Karunanidhi Salai. Robotic excavators are being used to remove silt deposits, solid waste and water hyacinths from the canal. He instructed officials to expedite the work and ensure its completion before the onset of the monsoon.

directed officials to carry out desilting works to prevent the formation of sandbars and facilitate the free flow of water. He stressed the importance of completing the work well in advance of the rainy season.

The Commissioner also inspected the Jafferkanpet Canal and instructed officials to maintain the waterway in a clean condition

through regular desilting and upkeep activities.

Interacting with residents during the visit, he appealed to the public not to dump garbage into canals and waterways, noting that such practices obstruct water flow and increase flood risks. He urged residents to hand over household waste to sanitation workers engaged in daily door-to-door collection.

# Minister stresses timely completion of rural development projects

Chennai, May 29: Rural Development and Water Resources Minister N. Anand on Thursday directed officials to ensure timely completion of rural development schemes with quality standards, stressing that all projects must be brought into public use without delay.

Chairing a review meeting on major schemes being implemented through the Rural Development and Panchayat Raj Department, the Minister said the economic growth of villages plays a crucial role in India's overall economic development and emphasised the need to improve living standards in rural areas through better infrastructure and welfare measures.

He instructed officials to maintain quality in all development works, particularly roads and bridges, and complete them within the stipulated time frame.

The Minister also stressed the importance of timely wage payments under the Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme and directed officials to provide drinking water connections to all households under the Jal Jeevan Mission. He further instructed authorities to ensure proper maintenance and cleaning of overhead water tanks to supply safe drinking water.

Emphasising effective implementation of the Swachh Bharat Mission, he called for 100 per cent segregation and disposal of waste and strengthening of solid waste management systems in villages.

### Registration slots increased for Vaikasi muhurtham day

Chennai, May 29:

To facilitate the large number of document registrations expected on the auspicious Vaikasi Muhurtham day - today, the Registration Department has announced additional pre-booking slots at all Sub-Registrar Offices across Tamil Nadu.

Acting on requests from the public, the government has increased the number of booking slots to ensure smoother registration services and reduce waiting time for applicants.

Accordingly, in Sub-Registrar Offices with a single Sub-Registrar, the number of pre-booking slots has been raised from 100 to 150. In offices with two Sub-Registrars, the slots have been increased from 200

to 300.

Further, in 100 Sub-Registrar Offices that typically witness heavy registration activity, the regular booking slots have been enhanced from 100 to 150. To meet additional demand, four extra Tatkal booking slots have also been introduced, taking the total number of Tatkal slots available to the public from 12 to 16.

The move is expected to help the public complete property and document.
