Learned counsel for the respondents has produced a copy of communication dated 07.07.2026, issued by the Deputy Divisional Manager, HRTC, Taradevi Unit, which is taken on record.

2. A perusal of the same reveals that amounts of Rs.11,28,452/- and Rs.8,21,420/- were paid towards DCRG and leave encashment on 12.11.2025 through cheques, respectively. The interest on the aforesaid amounts to the tune of Rs.1,10,730/- and Rs.80,532/- has also been paid

through cheques on 02.07.2026.

Since the mandate contained in the judgment dated 22.08.2025 passed in **CWP No.12928 of 2025**, titled, ***Kala Verma vs. HRTC and others***, has been duly complied with, nothing remains to be adjudicated in the present execution petition and the same is accordingly closed. However, it is made clear that in case the aforesaid amounts paid through cheques have not been credited in the account of the petitioner, she shall be at liberty to file an application for revival of the present execution petition after two weeks from today.
