01. 1. Heard Mr. Nanda, learned counsel for the Petitioner and Mr. Pattnaik, learned AGA for the State.
2. The Petitioner's grievance is about the irregularities relating to selection of lowest Bidder (L1) pursuant to the RFP at Annexure-1.
3. According to the Petitioner, Opposite Party No.2 – who stood L1 in the process of bid, does not qualify the basic eligibility, in terms of the notifications under Annexure-3 & 4, to participate in the tender process. It is also submitted on behalf of the Petitioner



that, the Petitioner has made a grievance petition to learned District Judge, Balangir alleging all such irregularities.

4. Accordingly, we are inclined to dispose of the writ petition at the stage of admission, without expressing any opinion on the merits of contentions of the petitioner, with a direction to the Registrar, Civil Courts, Balangir (O.P.No.1) to consider the grievance of the Petitioner as per his representation at Annexure-8 and take decision, in accordance with law, after granting due opportunity of hearing to the Petitioner as well as Opposite Party No.2, within a period of ten (10) days from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order along with a copy of the writ petition.

5. Since it is submitted that the work order has not been made effective as on date, it is directed that the work order may not be given effect to till such decision is taken by Opposite Party No.1.

6. Issue urgent certified copy in course of the day.
