O R D E R

1. Leave granted.
2. The appeal lies on a very short compass.
3. It is filed against the order passed by the Trial Court, later confirmed by the High Court, wherein the application filed by the appellant for production of additional documents, was rejected on the ground of delay.
4. It is not in dispute that the suit is one for recovery of money. The appellant before us is the plaintiff. The document sought to be produced are the documents issued by the respondent(s) themselves. In other words, in any case the documents are not in dispute.
5. In our considered view, both the Courts have adopted a very hyper technical approach in rejecting the application, merely on the ground of delay. Suffice, it is to state that the appellant being a plaintiff has to prove his case to the satisfaction of the Trial Court.
6. In such view of the matter, the impugned order passed by the

High Court confirming the order of the Trial Court stands set aside. The application for production of additional documents stands allowed. The respondents are permitted to file additional written statement, if any, within a period of six weeks thereafter.

7. The appeal is allowed in above terms.
8. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
