A W A R D

1. Heard Mr. V. N. Raghupathy, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and Mr. Vikas Gupta, learned counsel appearing for the respondent no.1 -Insurance Company assisted by Mr. Kumar Vijayant, Assistant Manager (Legal) of United India Insurance Co. Ltd.

2. We have interacted with learned counsel representing the respective parties.

3. The Motor Accident Claims Tribunal (MACT) had awarded compensation of Rs 10,50,400/- (Rupees Ten Lakhs Fifty Thousand and Four Hundred) along with interest @ 8% which was enhanced by the High Court to Rs 12,88,000/- (Rupees Twelve Lakhs Eighty Eight Thousand), however High Court has reduced interest payable to 6%.

4. After consultation and negotiations, the parties have arrived at a settlement. It is now agreed that respondent no.1 - United India Insurance Company Ltd. will pay a consolidated amount of Rs. 5,00,000/- (Rupees Five Lakhs), over and above to the amount granted by the High Court. The amount shall be paid within a period of six weeks from today.

5. In view of the agreement as recorded, the Special Leave Petition stands disposed of.
