JUDGMENT : (per Mr. Manoj Kumar Gupta, C. J.)

1. Mr. Ashish Joshi and Mr. Shobhit Joshi, learned counsel for the petitioner state that the dispute in the present matter is covered by the order passed today in WPMB No.565 of 2026.
2. The operative part of the order passed in the said case is as follows:-

“9. As the petitioner has raised a specific objection regarding non-compliance of the provisions of Section 30A of Recovery of Debts and Bankruptcy Act, 1993 and therefore, we dispose of the instant petition with direction to the DRT to decide the said issue expeditiously and preferably on the next date, and until the same is decided, it shall not proceed to pass any orders on merits.”
