O R D E R

The matters have been placed before the Court at the behest of the Registry seeking directions with regard to the amount, which was deposited by the petitioner-National Insurance Company Limited with the Registry and the value of which is Rs.1,33,96,074/- (Rupees One Crore Thirty Three Lakhs Ninety Six Thousand and Seventy Four), which has been invested in a Fixed Deposit and is maturing on 11.09.2026.

2. Mr. Ashok Mathur, learned Advocate-on-Record is appearing on behalf of the respondent no.1, who is now deceased and represented by his mother Ms. Rajinder Kaur.

3. Today, the mother and the unmarried younger sister of the deceased respondent no.1 are also present in the Court.

4. We are informed that there is also one married sister and father, who are the legal heirs of the deceased respondent no.1.

5. The elder married sister of the deceased respondent no.1 has also joined the Court proceedings virtually and submits that her share in the amount be given to her mother-Ms. Rajinder Kaur.

6. In view of the aforesaid position, learned counsel for the deceased respondent no.1 submits that he shall file a proper application supported by an affidavit with regard to the proposal of how the amount, which is lying with the Registry of this Court, be disbursed among the heirs of the deceased respondent no.1.

7. The same be done within two weeks.

8. The F.D.R. of Rs.1,33,96,074/- (Rupees One Crore Thirty Three Lakhs Ninety Six Thousand and Seventy Four), which is going to

mature on 11.09.2026 shall be renewed for a further period of three months with auto-renewal facility.

9. List on 06.10.2026.

10. The Court would request that on the next date of listing, the father of the deceased respondent no.1 be also present in the Court, either physically or through virtual mode. The younger sister of the deceased respondent no.1 submits that she shall convey such request to her father.
