UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

In continuation of the previous orders,
Mr. Ranjit Kumar, learned senior counsel appearing for
the petitioners submits that a sum of ₹ 2 Crores
(Rupees Two Crores Only) was disbursed to the
respondents only yesterday and has since been
credited to their respective bank accounts.

He further submitted that the petitioner-
institution is entitled to receive approximately ₹5
crores (Rupees Five Crores Only). from the State of
Maharashtra towards fee reimbursement/subsidy for
Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe students.

It was also submitted that the Bombay High Court, by an order passed yesterday, directed the Charity Commissioner to complete the sale of the petitioner's lands and properties within three months provided by the petitioner to the Charity Commissioner. As the order has not yet been uploaded, two weeks' time was sought to place it on record.

Learned senior counsel further stated that approximately ₹5 crores would be recovered from the sale proceeds, which, together with the subsidy amount, would cover the petitioner's tentative outstanding liability of about ₹10 crores payable to the respondents.

Mr. Shrirang B. Varma, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State of Maharashtra therefore, will obtain further instructions and file a fresh affidavit within two weeks indicating whether any subsidy amount is payable to the petitioner-institution and the quantum thereof, and the time frame within which the such payment would be released.

The petitioner is permitted to effect dasti service upon respondent No. 19 within one week and to file an affidavit of proof of service before the next date of hearing.
