2022 ● The Company's 12,000 MT greenfield plant at Sitarganj successfully commenced commercial production.

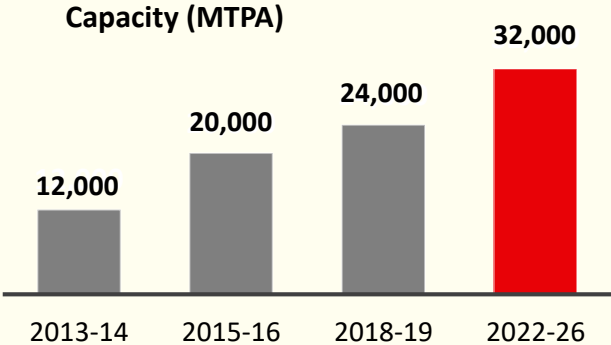
