1.            Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.
2.            We have perused the record and gone through the reliefs sought in the present writ petition. Having regard to the nature of the reliefs sought in the present petition, we find that the grievance raised by the petitioner can appropriately be considered and decided by the Grievance Committee constituted pursuant to the order dated 16.06.2026 passed by this Court in Writ Petition No.1775 of 2026. Since the reliefs sought by the petitioner squarely fall within the jurisdiction of the said Committee, we deem it appropriate to relegate the petitioner to avail the said remedy if so desired. Accordingly, the petitioner is at liberty to approach the Grievance Committee, which shall consider and decide the petitioner's grievance, as expeditiously as possible and in accordance with law.

3. The writ petition is, accordingly, disposed of in the aforesaid terms. All contentions of the parties are kept open.
