- 2.** Leave granted.
- 3.** Appellants are accused in Crime No.3/2025 alleging that complainant was induced to invest more than Rs,20,00,000/- through purported online trading platforms viz., i.e., Money Trade 365 and Skytrade. On the basis of

chats between the appellants and other persons concerning the creation of configuration and maintenance of websites and charges payable for such technical work resulting in appellants creating 38 websites, the appellants have been arraigned as accused.

4. Ms. Prabhleen A. Shukla, learned counsel appearing for the respondent - State opposes the grant of bail.

5. The co-accused Chetan, Vishal Yadav, Sandeep Sharma, Saurabh Mahur and Rohan Kandra have already been released on bail by order dated 05.02.2026. Appellants have been arrested on 03.04.2026 and 27.04.2026 respectively and are in custody till date. It is also to be noticed that complainant and the accused seems to have entered into a settlement and complainant is said to have received the amount. However, we do not propose to enter into any discussion on the same except noting it. Investigation having been concluded and chargesheet having been filed, custodial interrogation of appellants would not be warranted and their continued incarceration is also not warranted. Hence, we are of the

considered view that appellants are entitled to the relief sought for. Appeals are allowed. Appellants are ordered to be released on bail subject to such terms and conditions as the jurisdictional Court deems fit to impose.

6. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
