This application under Article 227 of the Constitution of India is at the instance of the plaintiff praying for a direction upon the learned Judge, Bench-VI, City Civil Court at Calcutta to dispose of Money Suit No. 19 of 2021 expeditiously.

The learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that the application under Order 39 Rule 1 and 2 of the Code of Civil Procedure filed by the petitioner has been withdrawn on 24th June, 2026 and 18th September, 2026 has been fixed for framing of issues.

In view of the order sought and proposed to be passed, there is no necessity to direct issuance of any notice upon the opposite parties. However, the learned advocate on record of the petitioner shall be obliged to forward a copy of this application along with a server copy of this order to the opposite parties forthwith.

In the light of the submissions made by the learned advocate for the petitioner, C.O. 2087 of 2026 stands disposed of by requesting the learned Judge, Bench-VI, City Civil Court at Calcutta to make an endeavour to dispose of

the Money Suit No. 19 of 2021 as expeditiously as possible without granting any unnecessary adjournments to either of the parties.

There shall be, however, no order as to costs.
