2. Learned counsel for the University, by referring to
the statement made in paragraphs 4 to 9, submits that the entire
admissible dues for which the petitioner is entitled, in respect of
gratuity, arrears of salary, group insurance, Earned Leave and
revised pay-scale under the U.G.C. have been extended and



nothing survives for adjudication.

3. The stand of the University has not been controverted by learned counsel for the petitioner. However, liberty is sought to address any pending grievance. Accordingly, the petitioner is granted liberty to approach the concerned authorities within four weeks from today.

4. It is made clear that if no such representation is filed within the period so allowed, the issues shall be given quietus.

5. With the aforesaid observation / directions, the instant case stands disposed of.
