UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. In this matter, by order dated 17.07.2026 of this Court, while recording that the parties should explore amicable resolution of the dispute through mediation, we appointed Mr.Suyodhan Byrapaneni, learned counsel as a Mediator to settle the dispute between the parties. Parties have entered into a settlement agreement dated 31.08.2026. Under the said settlement agreement, the appellant(first party) will pay a sum of Rs.2,32,00,000/- to the respondent (second party) in five installments as under:-

2. Today, Mr. Mukesh Jain, learned counsel for the appellant has handed over five cheques, one of them is dated 07.09.2026, the rest are post dated cheques as indicated above.

3. In view of the said settlement agreement and since the last of the installment falls due on 15.01.2027, we list this matter on 18th January, 2027.

4. Liberty is granted to mention.

5. Interim order to continue in the meantime.

6. Both parties acknowledge the efforts taken by Mr.Suyodhan Byrapaneni, learned counsel who acted as a Mediator to settle the dispute between the parties in this matter. Even though we have indicated in our order dated 17.07.2026, that learned Mediator shall fix his terms in consultation with the parties, the learned mediator has not yet done so and left it to the Court. The learned Mediator has put in more than 10 hours of labour over six sittings.

7. Considering the efforts taken by the learned Mediator, we fix the honorarium of Rs.10,00,000/-, which shall be paid by the parties in equal share and the same shall be paid within a

period of four weeks from today.
