Sub: Update on Ongoing Tax Litigation or disputes – Intimation under Regulation 30 of the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 ("SEBI Listing Regulations")

This is with reference to the Ongoing Tax Litigation or disputes disclosed in the Integrated Governance Report filed quarterly by the Company. The updates on tax litigations or disputes in terms of sub-para 8 of para B of Part A of Schedule III read with corresponding provisions of Annexure 18 of the Master Circular dated November 11, 2024 are given below:

1	Name of the opposing party	The Commissioner of Service Tax, Kolkata
2	Date of initiation of the litigation / dispute	23-06-2014
3	Status of the litigation / dispute as per last disclosure	The Company has filed an appeal against the order passed by Commissioner of Service Tax demanding Rs. 65,19,360/- alleging contravention of the provisions of the Finance Act, 1994 and non-payment of service tax, education cess and H.E. Cess., before CESTAT on 23.06.2014. The hearing was scheduled on 29.01.2025 and then rescheduled to 10.03.2025. The hearing date was further extended to 21.05.2025, where they asked for certain documents. The hearing was scheduled on 05.06.2025; 23.07.2025, 15.09.2025, 08.12.2025, 12.03.2026 and then rescheduled to 15.06.2026.
4	Current status of the litigation / dispute	The Company have received the Final Order under Service Tax Appeal pronounced on 30.07.2026; on 03-08-2026. The Authority held that the impugned demand of service tax is not sustainable. Accordingly, the same is set aside and no penalties are imposable on the Company. Hence, the appeal filed by the appellant (i.e. Company) is allowed

		with consequential relief, if any. Therefore, there is no material financial impact on the Company.
