Systematic Industries Limited acquires GI Wire Plant in Chhattisgarh Enhances capacity, expands geographic reach, and strengthens position in high-growth infrastructure segments

Mumbai, 4 August 2026: Systematic Industries Limited (SIL), a leading manufacturer of specialised steel wires, cables and optical fibre solutions, today announced the acquisition of a Galvanized Iron (GI) Wire manufacturing facility located at Siltara, Chhattisgarh. The acquired facility spans approximately 10 acres and has an installed capacity of 48,000 metric tonnes per annum (MTPA) of GI wires.

Strategic Rationale: This acquisition is aligned with SIL's long-term strategy of scaling its core wire business and strengthening its presence in infrastructure-linked segments.

- **Capacity Expansion:** Enhances installed capacity by ~48%, taking total capacity to ~1,48,000 MTPA across five units
