O R D E R

1. Delay condoned.
2. It is contended that the learned Arbitrator has misconstrued the order of status quo passed by the High Court in relation to the subject land and as a result thereto, the pending arbitration proceedings have been kept in abeyance.
3. The appropriate recourse for the petitioner-authority would be to approach the High Court and seek clarification of the order of

status quo so that in light of the order dated 30.05.2025 passed by this Court in *M/s Riar Builders Pvt. Ltd. and Anr. v. Union of India and Ors.*, SLP (C) Diary No. 26933/2025, the arbitration proceedings under Section 34 can proceed further in accordance with law. Ordered accordingly.
