309.1. IA(IBC)/1431(CHE)2023 IN CP(IB)/196(CHE)2021

Present: Ld. Counsel Ms. Priyanka Varma for the Applicant.

Ld. Counsel Mr.T.Ravichandran for liquidator.

This is an Application seeking following reliefs :

a) Direct the 1st Respondent to pay the claim filed by the applicants of Rs.1,06,65,135/- and Rs.1,11,81,675/- totaling to a sum of Rs. 2,18,46,810/- (Two Crores Eighteen lakhs and Forty-Six Thousand Eight Hundred and Ten only);

b) Direct the 1st Respondent to treat the outstanding rental dues to the tune of Rs.1,46,47,920/- (excluding) (interest) from the period of March 2022 to July, 2023 as CIRP/Liquidation costs under section 53 of the IBC, 2016 and further direct to pay the rentals till date of vacating the premises in priority;

We find that liquidator is yet to pass a speaking order in respect of claim filed by the Applicant and the liquidator is directed to consider the claim on merits and pass speaking order within two weeks. If the Applicant is aggrieved by this order of this liquidator the Applicant may approach the court. Accordingly, **IA(IBC)/1431(CHE)2023 is disposed of.**

309.2. IA(IBC)/1607(CHE)2023 IN CP(IB)/196(CHE)2021

This is an Application seeking to vacate and handover the possession of properties of the Applicant and the Applicant stated that same has been handed over. Therefore nothing survives in this Application and **IA(IBC)/1607(CHE)2023 is disposed of as infructuous.**

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309.3. IA(IBC)/1419(CHE)2023 IN CP(IB)/196(CHE)2021

This is an Application seeking following reliefs :

a) Direct the 1st Respondent to admit the full claim amount as filed by the applicants of Rs.1,06,65,135/- and Rs.1,11,81,675/- totaling to a sum of Rs. 2,18,46,810/- (Two Crores Eighteen lakhs and Forty-Six Thousand Eight Hundred and Ten only).
