UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. Mr. Bishwajit Dubey, learned Additional Advocate General for the State of Chhattisgarh has taken instructions and submits that without prejudice, they can consider the offer of the appellant.
2. It may be noted that petitioner's bid as regards the first tender notice dated 17.09.2025 culminated in the petitioner being declared as L-1. However, the tender committee decided not to proceed with the bid. As regards the second tender notice dated 10.09.2025, the petitioner was again declared as L-1 however, the same was cancelled on 27.03.2026.
3. Mr. P.B. Suresh, learned senior counsel assisted by Mr. Kaustubh Shukla for the petitioner would submit that in the negotiations petitioner will be inclined to reduce the price offered by it on earlier occasion.
4. Having recorded the submission of the parties, we leave it open to the State Government to consider the matter in detail and take necessary decision.
5. Pending disposal of the Special Leave Petitions, the impugned judgment in so far as it directs the State to pay compensation to the petitioner shall remain stayed.
