O R D E R

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in connection with FIR No. 469/2022 dated 24.08.2022 registered at Police Station, Safdarjung Enclave, District South- West, New Delhi, for the offences punishable under Sections 409 and 420 of the Indian Penal

Code, 1860.

3. The petitioner being a Deputy Manager, SBI at the relevant point of time is alleged to have misappropriated certain amount of money. It is not in dispute that the total amount which is said to have been misappropriated by her is about Rs. 1,35,00,000/- (Rupees One Crore Thirty Five Lakhs). However, as per the material on record, in the charge sheet there is a statement that almost Rs. 1,64,00,000/- (Rupees One Crore Sixty Four Lakhs) has been recovered from her.

4. Learned counsel for the State does not oppose this factual position.

5. Having regard to the fact that the petitioner has been custody for almost a year and is a lady and the amount which is said to have been defalcated/misappropriated having been recovered from her, we don't find any necessity for the petitioner to remain in incarceration.

6 Accordingly, the petitioner be released on bail on conditions as may be set by the Trial Court and subject to her cooperating during the trial.

7. The Special Leave Petition and pending applications, if any, shall stand disposed of.
