ORDER

1. APPEAL/52(KB)2026:

- a. The Impugned Order dated 13th of March, 2026, as it appears from page 16 of this Application passed by the Ld. Registrar under Rule 28 (4) states the following:

Thus, in terms of Rule 28 (4) of the NCLT Rules, 2016, on your failure to cure the defects pointed in the notice dated 15/01/2024/new defects found, I decline to register your Petition/Application/Document.

- b. Ld. Counsel Ms. Debaleena Ganguly appearing on behalf of the Applicant submits that she is ready and willing to rectify the defects within a period of seven days.

- c. Accordingly, once the defect as pointed out, is rectified to the satisfaction of the Registry, the Registry shall open the portal and allow filing and registration of the Petition.
- d. In view of above, Impugned Order dated 13th March, 2026 is quashed and, accordingly, APPEAL/ 52(KB)2026 is **allowed** and **disposed of**.
