UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. Heard Mr. Tushar Mehta, learned Solicitor General of India appearing for the petitioner and Mr. Abhishek Chaudhary, learned counsel appearing on caveat on behalf of respondent No.1.

2. Application for exemption from filing official translation is allowed.
3. Delay condoned.
4. Learned Solicitor General drawing attention to page 48 and 50 (pdf 75 and 76 of the paper book) submits that the land in question forming part of Khasra No.232 is shown as 'rasta' and 'charm sodhak sthan'. Learned Solicitor General submits that in view of this regularizing the land in favour of the respondents would be prejudicial to public interest.
5. Issue notice.
6. Mr. Abhishek Chaudhary, learned counsel accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1, on caveat.
7. As prayed, four weeks' time is granted to file a counter affidavit.
8. List the matter for further consideration on 2nd November, 2026.
9. In the meantime, *status quo*, as on today, shall be maintained by the parties. There shall also be stay of contempt proceedings against the petitioner.
10. Pleadings be completed in the meantime.
