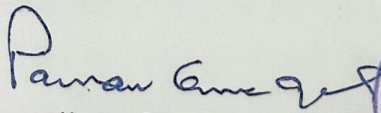

Report on the Audit of the Annual Financial Results

Opinion

We have audited the accompanying annual financial results of **Standard Surfactants Limited**, (the "Company") for the quarter and the year ended March 31, 2026 ("the Statement") attached herewith, being prepared and submitted by the Company pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended ("Listing Regulations").

In our opinion and to the best of our information and according to the explanations given to us, the aforesaid Statement:

- (i) is presented in accordance with the requirements of Regulation 33 of the Listing Regulations in this regard; and
- (ii) give a true and fair view in conformity with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in the applicable Indian Accounting Standards ('Ind AS') specified under section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 ('the Act'), read with the Companies (Indian Accounting Standards) Rules, 2015 and other accounting principles generally accepted in India, of the net profit, total comprehensive income and other financial information of the Company for the quarter and the year ended March 31, 2026.

Basis for Opinion

This responsibility also includes maintenance of adequate accounting records in accordance with the provisions of the Act for safeguarding of the assets of the Company and for preventing and detecting frauds and other irregularities; selection and application of appropriate accounting policies; making judgments and estimates that are reasonable and prudent; and the design, implementation, and maintenance of adequate internal financial controls, that were operating effectively for ensuring the accuracy and completeness of the accounting records, relevant to the preparation and presentation of the Statement that give a true and fair view and are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

In preparing the Statement, the Management and the Board of Directors are responsible for assessing the Company's ability to continue as a going concern, disclosing, as applicable, matters related to going concern and using the going concern basis of accounting unless the Board of Directors either intends to liquidate the Company or to cease operations, or has no realistic alternative but to do so.

The Board of Directors are also responsible for overseeing the financial reporting process of the Company.

Our conclusions are based on the audit evidence obtained up to the date of our auditor's report. However, future events or conditions may cause the Company to cease to continue as a going concern.
- Evaluate the overall presentation, structure and content of the Statement, including the disclosures, and whether the Statement represents the underlying transactions and events in a manner that achieves fair presentation
- Obtain sufficient appropriate audit evidence regarding the Statement of the company to express an opinion on the annual financial results.

- 3 These Audited Standalone Financial results which are published in accordance with Regulation 33 of SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended, (Listing Regulations) have been reviewed by the Audit Committee and Board of Directors at their respective meetings held on 25 June 2026. These audited Standalone Financial Statements have been prepared in accordance with recognition and measurement principles of Indian Accounting Standards (Ind-AS) prescribed under section 133 of the Companies Act 2013, read with relevant rules made thereunder and other accounting principles generally accepted in India.
- 4 The figures for the quarter ended March 31, 2026 are the balancing figures between the audited figures in respect of the full financial year and the published unaudited year to date figures up to the third quarter of the financial year.
- 5 On May 3rd, 2026, a fire incident occurred at spray dryer plant of the company situated at industrial Area Mandideep. The Company is assessing the extent of the damaged and consequent loss and amount of claim recoverable from the insurance company.
- 6 On November 21, 2025 the Government of India notified four labour codes i.e. the Code on Wages, 2019, the Industrial Relations Code, 2020, the Code on Social Security, 2020, and the Occupational Safety, Health and Working Conditions Code, 2020 (New Labour Codes) consolidating 29 existing labour laws. The Ministry of Labour & Employment published draft Central Rules and FAQs to enable assessment of financial impact due to these changes in regulations. Based on information available and guidance provided by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India, the company has assessed impact of these changes and is of the view that there will be no material financial impact of the same. It continues to monitor the developing regulatory scenario, including finalisation of Central/ State Rules and clarifications from the Government on other aspects of labour codes. The accounting effect of such developments, if any, would be appropriately considered.
- 7 Figures for the previous corresponding periods have been regrouped, wherever considered necessary.
