O R D E R

1. Leave granted.
2. This appeal would call in question the order passed by the High Court, refusing to modify the condition imposed by the Trial court whereby the appellant was directed to deposit an aggregate amount of ₹31,32,119/- as on February 2025, by means of fixed deposit receipt drawn in favour of the Competent Authority / District Revenue Officer, Chennai, within two months from the date of the order passed by the Special Court, Special Judge under the Tamil Nadu Protection of Interests of Depositors (in Financial Establishments) Act, 1997 on 06.03.2025, as a condition for release of original document, as mentioned in the order.
3. When the matter was taken up for

consideration on 27.07.2026, learned counsel for the appellant argued that he is ready to deposit the amount with interest calculated till March 2023, during which period the finance company (Respondent No. 3, M/s Paraspara Sahaya Nidhi (Perambur) Ltd.) was conducting its business. It was also submitted that while dealing with a similar issue against the same company, the High Court in its order dated 07.10.2025 in Criminal Revision Case No. 1926 of 2025 directed the concerned appellant to pay the amount calculated till March 2023, as a condition for the release of the original title deeds.

4. Upon the aforesaid submission of learned counsel for the appellant, this Court directed the parties to submit an agreed calculation sheet as to the amount the appellant would be required to pay by calculating the non-default interest till March 2023.

5. Respondent-State has filed I.A. No.230870/2026 seeking permission to file additional documents with an affidavit, *inter alia*, stating that as on March 2023, the appellant was required to pay a balance sum of ₹9,55,957/-. The appellant has no objection to the said calculation put forth by the respondent-State.

6. In the above view of the matter, we dispose of

this appeal, directing that in the event the appellant deposits the sum of ₹9,55,957/- before the Trial Court within a period of two months from today, the original documents, as referred in the Trial Court order dated 06.03.2025, shall be returned to the appellant.

7. Further, the amount of ₹15,00,000/- deposited by the appellant in the Registry of this Court shall be returned to the appellant with interest, if any, so that this amount is also deposited before the Trial Court within the next two months.

8. The Appeal is disposed of in the above terms.

9. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
