This is an application to extend the time granted for curing the defects.

The facts giving rise to present IA (re-filing) are that the Appellant e-filed the Memo of Appeal on 20.03.2026. The Office after scrutiny of the Memo of Appeal on 27.03.2026, intimated the defects to the Appellant on the same day. The Appellant re-filed the Appeal on 13.05.2026. It is stated in the IA that the present matter involved voluminous records and annexures, including invoices, ledger statements, agreements, GST records, correspondence, arbitral pleadings and other supporting documents, which required substantial compilation, pagination, verification and curing of office objections. The Authorized Representative of the Appellant fell seriously ill and was diagnosed with jaundice and was admitted to the hospital. Thereafter, the Appeal was refiled, but objections were again notified by the Registry, curing which took some time. Hence, there is delay of 40 days in re-filing the Memo of Appeal, so the same may be condoned.

Heard learned Counsel appearing for the Appellant and perused the averments made in the IA as well as Office report.

The Appellant was required to re-file the Memo of Appeal within seven days from the date of intimation of the defects. However, the Appellant re-filed the Memo of Appeal with a delay of 40 days, hence, the case may be placed before the Hon'ble Bench with defect for appropriate orders.
