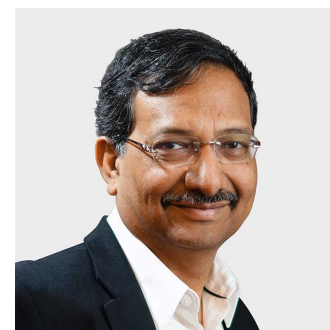
Advancing Enterprise AI with MSOCK: Multi-Dimensional, Multi-Layer System of Connected Knowledge
