UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. Delay in filing the SLP and refiling the same is condoned.
2. Heard learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the respondents.
3. The Respondent herein has completed her Law in the year 2022 and having regard to the fact that the impugned

judgment and order passed by the High Court has already been implemented, we are of the opinion that interference under Article 136 of the Constitution of India is not warranted.

4. We may also observe that we have not approved of the approach adopted by the High Court in allowing that Writ Petition. The question of law raised by the learned counsel for the petitioner is substantial in nature. The question of law is kept open for having considered in an appropriate case. We also make it clear that the decision of the High Court shall not be treated as a precedent.

5. The petitioner shall release the final marksheet incorporating the revised result of the First and Second Semesters within a period of six weeks from today.

6. With this clarification, the Special Leave Petition is, accordingly disposed of and the accompanying interlocutory application(s), if any, also stands disposed of.
