This is an application to extend the time granted for curing the defects.

The facts giving rise to present IA (re-filing) are that the Applicant e-filed the Interlocutory Application (IA) on 18.05.2026. The Office after scrutiny of the IA on 30.07.2026, intimated the defects to the Applicant on the same day. The Applicant re-filed the IA on 16.09.2026. It is stated in the Interlocutory Application (IA) that though the defects were cured, but the Registry marked defects multiple times. The authorised signatory of the Appellant was located in Pune and owing to heavy rains in Pune during the relevant period, the courier/transit of the requisite hard copies of the documents from Pune to the office of the counsel at New Delhi was delayed. Hence, there is delay in re-filing the IA, so the same may be condoned.

Heard Ld. Counsel appearing for the Applicant and perused the averments made in the IA as well as Office report.

The Applicant was required to re-file the IA within seven days from the date of intimation of the defects. However, the Applicant re-filed the IA with a delay of 41 days, hence, the IA may be placed before the Hon'ble Bench with defect for appropriate orders.

It is submitted by Ld. Counsel for the Applicant that main Appeal is coming up for hearing before Court No.I on 24.09.2026 and this IA may be listed along with the main Appeal. In view of the above submission, let this IA (Delay in re-filing) be placed before Court No.1 on 24.09.2026.
