This Appeal has been preferred under Rule 63 of NCLT Rules, 2016 against the order dated 07.04.2026, whereby the Registry declined to register the Application filed under Section 54(1) of IBC, 2016 (Diary No. 3305118010882026). The defect(s) pointed out by the Registry are as under:-

*“1. Remove the first page. (MUMBAI BENCH IN IA//2026  
IN CASE No.C.P/IB/1366/2025)*

*2. Final report of the Liquidator to be filed. Above defects  
are not complied. Hence returned again. To comply with  
clarification note with the page number of the above  
documents.”*

It is stated that the Appellant filed an application on the e-filing portal on 30.03.2026, but the Registry raised defect note on 01.04.2026.

It is stated that the Appellant cured the defects and refiled on 03.04.2026. However, the Registry declined to register.

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It is stated that the Appellant had travelled to Kerala to cast his vote. There was a delay of 12 days.

Considering the fact that the defects have been rectified, appeal is allowed. Appellant is directed to re-file the application in a week's time.

Appeal is disposed of.
