02. 1. Heard Mr. Panda, learned counsel for the Petitioner and Mr. Patnaik, learned Additional Government Advocate for the State.



2. This writ application has been filed primarily seeking a direction to Debt Recovery Tribunal (DRT), Cuttack to dispose of I.A. Diary No.214 of 2025 seeking stay of further proceeding pursuant to notice dated 31.01.2023 and 11.09.2024 under Section 13(4) of the Securitization and Reconstruction of Financial Assets & Enforcement of Security Interest (SARFAESI) Act, 2002 by the Opposite Party Nos.1 and 2.

Pursuant to order dated 17.06.2026, Mr. Panda, learned counsel for the Petitioner has filed copy of such I.A. Diary No.214 of 2025.

3. Mr. Panda, learned counsel for the Petitioner submits that after condonation of delay, NDN No.32 of 2025 (SA) has been registered as SA No.172 of 2025 and the same is posted 30.06.2026 before the Debt Recovery Tribunal (DRT).

4. Considering the submission of the learned counsel, but, without going into the merits of the submission of the learned counsel for the Petitioner, the writ application is disposed of calling upon the DRT to take up I.A. Diary No.214 of 2025 on 30.06.2026 and make an endeavor to dispose of the same on the same day, if there is no other legal impediment.

5. It is needless to state that till the aforementioned I.A. Diary No.214 of 2025 is disposed of by the DRT, no coercive action shall be taken against the Petitioner in terms of the notice of the District Magistrate-cum-Collector, Sundargarh vide letter No.1424 dated 23.04.2026 subject to Petitioner appearing on



30.06.2026 and cooperating for disposal of the I.A. failing which, it is needless to state that it shall be open for the DRT to proceed in accordance with law.
