O R D E R

IA.No. 191065 of 2026

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner.

2. Pursuant to the order dated 07.07.2026 passed by this  
Court, an affidavit of undertaking dated 08.07.2026 has been  
filed on behalf of the petitioner. Paragraphs 10 and 11 thereof  
read as follows:

**"10. I respectfully submit that out of the total cheque amount of Rs. 23,12,673/- my father had deposited Rs. 4,62,535/- on 19.08.2019 in CC No. 442 and 444 of 2018, transferred a sum of Rs. 5,40,000/- between 5.11.2025 to 11.11.2025 and presently I have taken a demand draft for Rs. 5 lakh in the name of the Registrar of Supreme Court of India. The calculation is as follows:**

**Total Cheque amount                      Rs. 23,12,673/-**

**Amount deposited in CC  
No.442 and 444 of 2018                      Rs. 4,62,535/-**

**SBI Bank transfer                              Rs. 5,40,000/-**

**Demand Draft 6.7.2026                      Rs. 5,00,000/-**

**Balance cheque amount to be paid Rs. 8,10,138/-**

**11. I respectfully submit that I undertake on behalf of my father to deposit a sum of Rs. 10 lakh before this Hon'ble Court within a period of 4 weeks in compliance with the order passed by this Hon'ble Court on 7.7.2026 and I most respectfully pray this Hon'ble Court with folded hands to grant bail to my father so that my father could come out of jail and thereafter mobilize funds and deposit the same before this Hon'ble Court within a period of 4 weeks."**

**3. Having regard to the averments made in the aforesaid affidavit, particularly, paragraphs 10 and 11 thereof, we direct that the petitioner be released on interim bail, subject to such terms and conditions as may be imposed by the Trial Court. The Interlocutory Application is, accordingly, allowed.**

**4. It is, however, made clear that the petitioner shall deposit a sum of Rs.10,00,000/- within a period of four weeks**

from today, strictly in terms of the undertaking furnished before this Court. In the event of failure to comply with the said undertaking within the stipulated period, the interim bail granted by this order shall stand vacated automatically, without any further reference to this Court.

5. The affidavit of undertaking is taken on record. The demand draft bearing No. 745616 dated 06.07.2026 for a sum of Rs. 5,00,000/- shall be deposited with the Registry of this Court. The amount so deposited shall remain subject to such further orders as may be passed in the Special Leave Petition.
