UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. Since the petitioner's Writ Petition(s) and his prayer for interim relief is pending consideration before the High Court, we do not want to enter into the merits of the matter, as the same would affect the contentions of either of the parties before the High Court.
2. At the same time, we are of the view that the High Court should have passed orders on petitioner's prayer for interim relief, otherwise on or after 30.06.2026, the Writ Petition(s) shall be rendered infructuous.

3. In the above view of the matter, we dispose of the Special Leave Petition(s), directing the petitioner to move an application for preponement of hearing, for deciding his prayer for interim relief on merits.

4. In the meanwhile, till the petitioner's prayer for interim relief is considered and decided by the High Court, the parties shall maintain *status quo* in respect of the subject matter of the Writ Petition(s).

5. We request the High Court to decide the matter(s) expeditiously.

6. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
