O R D E R

1. In terms of settlement between the parties recorded on 26.10.2025, the co-accused gave demand draft bearing No. 36447201 of Union Bank of India dated 14.10.2025 for a sum

of Rs.17,50,000/- (Rupees seventeen lakhs fifty thousand only) to the complainant. However, according to the complainant this draft was never delivered to him. He also submits that draft has not been encashed and rather it was retained by some other person.

2. Let the Investigating Officer specifically investigate the crime in respect of demand draft for Rs.17,50,000/-.

3. An affidavit by the Investigating Officer shall be filed after conducting the investigation on this aspect.

4. List on 17.08.2026.

5. Interim order dated 15.01.2026 to continue, till the next date of hearing.
