This Appeal has been preferred under Rule 63 of NCLT Rules, 2016 against the order dated 11.06.2026, whereby the Registry declined to register the petition under Section 9 of IBC, 2016 (Diary No.3305118018352026). The defect(s) pointed out by the Registry are as under:-

“1.Payment mode in offline. To attach Bharatkosh payment receipt copy in the e-filing portal. not complied.

2. To affix for Rs.120/- Welfare stamps and Rs.20/ for clerk stamps and for Rs.10/- court fee stamps in Vakalat. not complied.

3. To file Board resolution for Authorizing the person to file the petition. not complied

4. To Attach Serving of copy of the petition to the corporate debtor and IBBI along with proof of service. not complied ”

It is stated that the Appellant filed the petition on the e-filing portal on 25.05.2026. The Registry raised a defect note on 26.05.2026.

It is stated that at the time of filing, the payment window crashed. Therefore, filing was done with payment in offline mode.

It is stated that the defects could not be cured in time as a result the Registry declined to register

Considering the submissions in the application, a week's time is granted to rectify the defects.
