O R D E R

1. Mr. Ashwin V. Kotemath, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the amount as directed by the High Court, is ready and the petitioners will deposit the same within three working days.

Considering the fact that the petitioners are willing to deposit the amount as ordered by the High Court, on or before 27.07.2026 before the Trial Court concerned, we direct that in the event of the amount being deposited, the impugned order will stand set aside and the High Court may hear the revision
