O R D E R

We have heard Shri Ranjit Kumar, learned senior counsel for the applicant/respondent no.3, learned counsel appearing for the respondent/University and learned counsel for the students, who are pursuing their studies in Sinhgad Dental College.

It is submitted by learned senior counsel for the applicant and learned counsel for the students who are pursuing their studies in Sinhgad Dental College that paragraph 7 of order dated 22.05.2026 squarely apply to them and therefore, subsequent Circular dated 30.06.2026 and letter dated 02.07.2026 do not apply to the students, who are pursuing their studies in Sinhgad Dental College.

It is submitted by learned senior counsel for the applicant that presently 599 students are pursuing their studies in the said college in the present academic

year. Consequently, order dated 25.06.2026 would be applicable only to 16 students/applicants and other students, who have already joined other colleges after order dated 25.06.2026.

We dispose of this application by reiterating what was stated in paragraph 7 of Order dated 22.05.2026, as under -

"We, therefore, permit the students to continue their respective courses in the third respondent - Institution for the current academic year 2025-26 which would also mean that they are entitled to appear in the examination(s), internals etc. in terms of their eligibility. Further, the results of the said examination(s) shall also be declared."

Consequently, Circular dated 30.06.2026 and letter dated 02.07.2026 would not be applicable to the students who are pursuing their studies in Sinhgad Dental College.

The Miscellaneous Application stands disposed of.
