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**IHCL CLOCKS 20 SIGNINGS AND 11 HOTEL OPENINGS IN Q1 FY2027
REACHES A PORTFOLIO OF 645 HOTELS WITH OVER 66,000 KEYS**



MUMBAI, JULY 7, 2026: Indian Hotels Company (IHCL), India’s largest hospitality company, continues its growth momentum with the signing of 20 hotels in the first quarter of FY2027 reaching a portfolio of **645** hotels with an industry leading pipeline of **263** hotels. In the quarter the company also opened 11 new hotels across its brandscape.

Ms. Suma Venkatesh, Executive Vice President - Real Estate & Development, IHCL said, “With a focus on our growth brands seventeen of the twenty signings this quarter were across **Gateway, Ginger** and **Tree of Life**. These included new destinations and emerging markets like Bharatpur, Trichy, Sindhudurg, Jawai, Wayanad and deeper penetration in established markets of Mumbai, Goa, Agra and Kolkata.”

She added, “Taj reached a milestone of 150 hotel portfolio with three signings this quarter growing its leisure footprint to Dharamshala, Barapani in Meghalaya and Kusr valley in Maharashtra.”

IHCL is well poised to achieve its goal of a **700-hotel** portfolio under its strategic roadmap - **Accelerate 2030**.
