UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. This Court on 22.04.2024 has issued limited notice only on the point of backwages, returnable in eight weeks. In spite of the fact that no order was passed staying the reinstatement, the respondents were not reinstated for the reasons best shown to the petitioner.

2. On 25.03.2026, it was brought to the notice of this Court that the workmen have not been reinstated and the learned counsel for the petitioner took two weeks time to do the needful i.e. to reinstate the workmen. Unfortunately, the workmen have not been reinstated so far. This Court has carefully gone through the judgment and is of the opinion that in the facts and circumstances of the case backwages were rightly granted to workmen in question

and, therefore, no case for interference is made out in the matter.
Hence, the special leave petition is dismissed.
