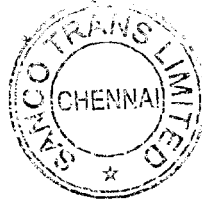
Notes on audited financial results:

- (1) The above Standalone unaudited financial results were reviewed by the Audit Committee and then approved by the Board of Directors at their Meeting held on May 28, 2026. The information for the year ended March 31, 2026 and March 31, 2025 presented above is extracted from the audited standalone financial statements for the year ended March 31, 2026. These financial statements are prepared in accordance with the Indian Accounting Standards (IND AS) as prescribed under section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013.
- (2) **Segment Information:**
The Company is principally engaged in a single business segment viz. Logistics based on nature of service, risks, returns and the internal business reporting system. The Board of Directors of the Company, which has been identified as being the Chief Operating Decision Maker (CODM), evaluates the Company's performance, allocate resources based on the analysis of the various performance indicators of the Company as a single unit. Accordingly, there is no other reportable segment in terms of Ind AS 108 'Operating Segments'.
- (3) The figures for the quarter ended March 31, 2026 and March 31, 2025 are balancing figures between the audited figures in respect of the full financial year ended March 31, 2026 and March 31, 2025 and year-to-date figures upto December 31, 2025 and December 31, 2024 respectively, which were subject to limited review by statutory auditors.
- (4) Exceptional items for the year ended March 31, 2026 represents enhanced compensation, net of legal expenses incurred, on compulsory acquisition of land during FY 2011-12, and the related interest thereon and amount provided for disputed taxes.

- (5) On November 21, 2025, Government of India notified provisions of the Code on Wages, 2019, the Industrial Relations Code, 2020, the Code on Social Security, 2020 and the Occupational Safety, Health and Working Conditions Code, 2020, ('Labour Codes') which consolidate twenty-nine existing labour laws into a unified framework governing employee benefits during employment and post-employment. The Labour Codes, amongst other things introduces changes, including a uniform definition of wages and enhanced benefits relating to leave. The Company has assessed the financial implications of these changes which has resulted in an increased gratuity liability arising out of past service cost by Rs. 2.46 Lakhs recognised in Employee benefits expense for the Quarter and Nine-months ended December 31, 2025. Rules under Labour codes were released by the Ministry of Labour and Employment on May 08, 2026. The company continues to monitor the development pertaining to the labour codes and will evaluate differential impact if any on the measurement of liability pertaining to employee benefits.
- (6) The Board of Directors have recommended a payment of dividend of Rs. 4.50 per equity share (on equity share of face value of Rs.10 each) for the year ended March 31, 2026. The payment is subject to the approval of the shareholder at the ensuing Annual General Meeting.
