UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following

O R D E R

1. The petitioner's grievance is that his claim for compensation in lieu of the acquired land has not been determined by the learned District Judge, Sonbhadra, for the last 34 years, though the High Court had fixed the period to decide such a claim vide an order dated 28.05.2024. It is also mentioned that some other aggrieved persons have already approached the High Court, and the matters are pending. It seems to us that the petitioner should also approach the High Court to seek either implementation of the earlier time-bound directions and/or to issue further directions to the learned District Judge, Sonbhadra, for expeditious disposal of the pending

cases. We have no reason to doubt that the High Court will look into the grievance of the petitioner and other similarly placed persons.

2. The Writ Petition is disposed of with pending application(s), if any.
