Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in compliance with the directions contained in the judgment sought to be executed, the petitioner has been paid the amount of gratuity to the tune of Rs.15,63,256/- and leave encashment of Rs.9,34,360/-. The only amount which is to be paid by the respondents-Corporation is the interest component. He undertakes to defray the amount of interest on the aforesaid components within a period of four weeks from today.

2. In view of the undertaking given by the learned

counsel for the respondents, nothing remains to be adjudicated in the present petition and the same is closed. However, it is made clear that in case the amount of interest is not paid within four weeks from today, the petitioner shall be at liberty to file an application for revival of the execution petition.
