O R D E R

1. Mr. Pawanshree Agrawal, learned Advocate-on-Record appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that appealable order was passed on 01.01.2025 but the amendment prescribing pre-deposit came

into effect only on 01.10.2025. In this view of the matter, he would submit that the condition of per-deposit cannot be a pre-condition for filing further appeal in this case.

2. Issue notice on the application seeking condonation of delay as well as on the Special Leave Petition, returnable on 14.08.2026.

3. In the meanwhile, the petitioner is permitted to file an appeal and the appeal be entertained without a pre-deposit. This will however be subject to the outcome of the present Special Leave Petition.
