1. This is the bail application U/S.483 of BNSS by the petitioner for grant of bail in connection with Hemagiri P.S. Case No. 256 of 2026 corresponding to GR Case No.252 of 2026 pending in the file of learned JMFC, Hemagiri for commission of offences punishable U/Ss.316(4)/318(4)/351(2)/3(5) of BNS, on the main allegation of misappropriating a sum of Rs.1,56,000/- of the company M/S. Shree Balaji Engicon Ltd. by drawing the same and not utilising it for the purpose it was drawn.

2. Heard, Mr. Amulya Ratan Panda, learned proxy counsel appearing on behalf of Mr.Mohan Charan Behera, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr.M.R.Patra, learned Addl. PP in the matter and perused the record.

3. After having considered the rival submissions and taking into consideration the nature and gravity of the offences as alleged against the petitioner vis-a-vis the accusations sought to be brought against him and regard being had to the pre-trial detention of the Petitioner in custody since 30.05.2026 with substantial progress of



investigation and taking into account the other circumstance on record in entirety including the inherent right of the accused-petitioner to be presumed innocent until proven guilty at the trial, this Court without expressing any view on merits, admits the petitioner to bail.

4. Hence, the bail application of the petitioner stands allowed and the petitioner is allowed to go on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand) with one solvent surety for the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned Court in seisin of the case on such terms and conditions as deem fit and proper by it.

5. Accordingly, the BLAPL stands disposed of. Issue urgent certified copy of the order as per Rules. A soft copy of this order be immediately communicated to the concerned Court, who shall afterwards communicate the same to the concerned Jail through e-mail for reference.
