UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. Permission to file special leave petition is granted.
2. Application (IA No. 296734/2026) for deletion of petition no.2 from the array of parties is allowed. Cause title be amended accordingly.

3. We have heard Ms. Menaka Guruswamy and Ms. Arundhati Katju, learned Senior Counsel for the petitioners, and Mr. Shiv Mangal Sharma, learned Additional Advocate General, on behalf of the State of Rajasthan.

4. Having regard to the issues raised by the petitioner, especially regarding women representation in the Rajasthan Cricket Association, we direct that though the election, which is scheduled to be held today, may take place, the results shall not be declared.

5. Meanwhile, we request the High Court to prepone the next date of hearing and make an endeavour to decide the case on merits, preferably on the date fixed. As regard to the wider issues, liberty is granted to the petitioner to join the pending proceedings before this Court in C.A. No.4235/2014 (Board of Control for Cricket in India v. Cricket Association of Bihar).

6. The Special Leave Petition is, accordingly, disposed of.

7. Pending applications, including the impleadment application, also stand disposed of.
