**Sub: Disclosure of events or information for Camlin Fine Sciences Limited (“Company”).**

Dear Sir/Madam,

**Shutdown of Diphenol Plant**

This is to inform that owing to the current geopolitical issues and economic environment, the availability and prices of key raw materials required for the diphenol plant of the Company, situated at Plot No. Z/96/D, Dahej SEZ -II, Tal. Vagra, Dist. Bharuch, Gujarat (“**Diphenol Plant**”), has been severely constrained. To mitigate the situation, the Company had reduced the capacity utilization of the Diphenol Plant and had initiated steps towards its shutdown.

The shutdown of the Diphenol Plant is not expected to affect production of downstream Straight products, as Hydroquinone has already been secured through imports contemplating the likely shutdown. The Company also has adequate Catechol inventory to support production of its Aroma products. Accordingly, the Diphenol facility will remain shut, and its restart will be evaluated based on improvements in the economic and geopolitical environment. Further, the Company is analyzing to re-purpose the Diphenol Plant and the utilization of the same shall be determined based on the economic scenarios.

There is no material impact on the operations of the Company and operations continues to be normal. Further, details as required under Regulation 30 of the SEBI Listing Regulations and SEBI Circular No. HO/49/14/14(7)2025-CFD-POD2/I/3762/2026 dated January 30, 2026, are provided in Annexure A.

**Fire Incident at Diphenol Plant**

A fire incident occurred at the Diphenol Plant of yesterday i.e., May 23, 2026, night around 11:30 p.m. As per prima facie evidence, the fire was caused due to leakage of high temperature thermic

fluid which spread quickly towards the flaking unit of the facility. The fire was brought under control and completely extinguished in an hour that is by 12.30 am on May 24, 2026.

Given the reduced level of activity and steps in process towards shutdown, the operations team was able to contain the fire promptly and prevent it from escalating. The swift response also enabled immediate evacuation, thereby avoiding any serious injuries to personnel at the Diphenol Plant.

As a precautionary measure, the Vanillin facility (where manufacture of Ethyl Vanillin was in progress) was immediately shut down.

Based on the preliminary assessment, the incident resulted in the loss of inventory of about 30 MT of Catechol and damage to the flaker machine, electrical cables, certain measuring instruments, and insulation. The estimated loss is around INR 2 crore.

The loss is adequately covered by insurance, and necessary steps are being initiated for the insurance claim.

The Company has informed all relevant regulatory authorities of the incident and taken necessary measures to prevent and contain any environmental hazards arising from the fire and its aftermath.

Following the initial safety and operational assessment, the Company plans to restart Ethyl Vanillin production. Based on the preliminary assessment, the restart is expected within the next 48 hours. Accordingly, the Company does not anticipate any impact on sales of downstream Straights and Aroma products.
