O R D E R

SLP (Crl) No.5054/2026

1. Heard Mr. Gaurav Agrawal, learned Senior Counsel for the petitioner, who is A-2, the Controller of Examination, Chhattisgarh Public Service Commission.

2. After hearing at some length, we consider it appropriate to adjourn the matter till July, 2026 to await the sanction with respect of A-8, the Secretary, Chhattisgarh Public Service Commission.

SLP (Crl) No.2363/2026

1. Heard Mr. Siddharth Dave, learned Senior Counsel for the petitioner, who is A-7, the Deputy

Controller of Examination, Chhattisgarh Public Service Commission.

2. After hearing at some length, we consider it appropriate to adjourn the matter till July, 2026 to await the sanction with respect of A-8, the Secretary, Chhattisgarh Public Service Commission.

SLP (CrI) No.19845/2025

1. Heard Mr. Rahul Kaushik, learned Senior Counsel for the petitioner and Mr. Davinder Pal Singh, learned Addl. Solicitor General appearing for the CBI.

2. The petitioner is involved in a leakage of question paper of the Chattisgarh Public Service Commission, pursuant to R.C. No.124/2024 dated 09.07.2024. The petitioner was arrested on 18.11.2024. The petitioner is the Director of a company known as M/s Bajrang Power and Ispat Limited. The said company provided funds under the CSR to the tune of Rs.45,00,000/- to a NGO named Gramin Vikas Samiti. The aforesaid funds were

provided on the basis of the report of the Committee by the CSR of the company and on the approval of the resolution by the Board of Directors. Both the aforesaid meetings were chaired by different persons, though the petitioner happened to be one of the members therein.

3. It is alleged that the Chairperson of the aforesaid NGO Gramin Vikas Samiti happened to be the wife of the Chairman of the Chhattisgarh Public Service Commission and since the funds provided to the said NGO, the Chairman conspired to leak the question paper to benefit the wards of the petitioner.

4. It may be noted that in the case at hand, charge sheet and supplementary charge sheet have been submitted long back and there are about 105 witnesses but the trial has not started so far, inasmuch as not even the charges have been framed. It may not be out of place to mention herein that all the candidates who benefitted by the leakage of the question paper, have already been granted

bail by the various Courts.

5. In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, as the petitioner is not the sole person who took the decision to supply funds to the NGO and that no custodial interrogation is now required, inasmuch as charge already been filed long back, we consider it appropriate to enlarge the petitioner on bail, subject to such terms and conditions as may be fixed by the Trial Court including that the petitioner will not leave the country without the leave of the Court and shall surrender his passport, if any, before the Trial Court.

6. Accordingly, the Special Leave Petition is disposed of.

7. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
